## Wartrace Regulators Auto Challenge

## Equipment:

Pistol, 100 rounds of ammo per each category entry to be safe. While you can shoot with just 2 magazines, 4 to 5 are best.

## Categories:

$9 \mathrm{~mm} / 40$

Pocket pistol any caliber with at least 6 round single stack
with at least 10 round magazine
with at least 10 round magazine
7 or 8 round magazine any non stock pistol

## Stages:

5 To Glock: there are five cardboard targets, normally at $5,10,15,20$ and 25 yards. You fire two shots per target. Each competitor shoots 3 strings of fire.

Glock M: There are four cardboard targets and one to three steel targets. Targets are set from 7 to 15 yards. You shoot 2 shots per cardboard target, leaving up to 3 shots to hit one steel target. Each competitor shoots 3 strings of fire.

The Plates: There are 6-8" knockdowns set at 11 yds. Each competitor shoots 4 strings of fire.

## Wartrace Regulators Auto Challenge

## Scoring:

Your score for each stage is the sum of the times for your strings of fire plus any penalty points. Shots in the 8/10in circle are zero penalty points. Shots in the 12 in circle are 1 penalty point. Shots outside the 12in but still on the cardboard are 3 penalty points. Misses of the target are 10 penalty points. Shots impacting and cutting the line will be awarded the lower penalty value.
